AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN STATE BUILDINGS TO BE ACCESSIBLE TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 29-269 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 State Building Code be amended to require any building leased to the
- 3 state by a private entity for use as a state facility and any state-owned
- 4 building that is being renovated, to add accessible equipment for
- 5 persons with disabilities to be compliant with the United States Access
- 6 Board Americans with Disabilities Act accessibility guidelines,
- 7 including wheelchair ramps, power-assist doors and accessible
- 8 restrooms and elevators.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that state buildings being renovated or buildings being leased to the state are accessible to persons with disabilities.
