AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE BEST PRACTICES FOR PROVIDING COMPREHENSIVE THERAPEUTIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That a study be required of the best practices for providing 2 comprehensive therapeutic educational programs to meet the mental 3 health needs of students in public schools that includes, but is not 4 limited to, a cost-benefit analysis of developing such programs within 5 the public school system.

To study best practices for providing comprehensive therapeutic education programs to meet the mental health needs of students in public schools.
