AN ACT REQUIRING HAIRDRESSERS AND COSMETICIANS TO BE TRAINED IN WORKING WITH CHILDREN WITH AUTISM AND OTHER SPECIAL NEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 20-252 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 registered hairdressers and cosmeticians to be trained in haircuts for
- 3 children with autism and other special needs.

To require registered hairdressers and cosmeticians to be trained in working with children with autism and other special needs.
