## AN ACT CONCERNING STATE AGENCY COMPLAINTS REGARDING INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS TO SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) prohibit any state elected
- 2 official, state agency or state employee from contacting any social media
- 3 platform to complain about or censure an individual or group, unless
- 4 the state agency of such official or employee has provided such
- 5 individual or group with a duly noticed public hearing prior to
- 6 contacting any such platform, with sufficient notice to such individual
- 7 or group of such public hearing, unless there is an emergency situation
- 8 which would require a hearing within forty-eight hours of such
- 9 complaint or censure, and (2) authorize such individual or group to
- 10 immediately appeal any adverse decision against such individual or
- 11 group to the Superior Court.

## Statement of Purpose:

To protect the right of free speech of individuals and groups.
