**AN ACT CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENTS TO FIRE COMPANIES  
FOR CALLS ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the State Fire
- 2 Administrator to pay one hundred dollars to each fire company for
- 3 each call to which such company responds on any limited access
- 4 highway, the Berlin Turnpike, the South Meadows Expressway and
- 5 the section of route 8 that falls within the boundaries of Naugatuck
- 6 State Forest, provided with respect to the Berlin Turnpike, such sum
- 7 shall be paid only if such call concerns a fire involving a motor vehicle.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the State Fire Administrator to reimburse fire companies that respond to certain calls.
