**Substitute Bill No. 6397**



**AN ACT EXPANDING THE DEFINITION OF A REPORTING ENTITY TO THE ALL-PAYER CLAIMS DATABASE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (A) of subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of  
2 section 19a-755a of the general statutes is repealed and the following is  
3 substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2021*):

4 (2) (A) "Reporting entity" means:

5 (i) An insurer, as described in section 38a-1, licensed to do health  
6 insurance business in this state;

7 (ii) A health care center, as defined in section 38a-175;

8 (iii) An insurer or health care center that provides coverage under  
9 Part C or Part D of Title XVIII of the Social Security Act, as amended  
10 from time to time, to residents of this state;

11 (iv) A third-party administrator, as defined in section 38a-720;

12 (v) A pharmacy benefits manager, as defined in section 38a-479aaa;

13 (vi) A hospital service corporation, as defined in section 38a-199;

14 (vii) A nonprofit medical service corporation, as defined in section

15 38a-214;

16 (viii) A fraternal benefit society, as described in section 38a-595, that  
17 transacts health insurance business in this state;

18 (ix) A dental plan organization, as defined in section 38a-577;

19 (x) A preferred provider network, as defined in section 38a-479aa;  
20 [and]

21 (xi) An entity that pays claims received by the entity, or an insurer  
22 acting on the entity's behalf, for treatment of any injury or illness under  
23 a medical care plan approved by the chairman of the Workers'  
24 Compensation Commission pursuant to chapter 568; and

25 [(xi)] (xii) Any other person that administers health care claims and  
26 payments pursuant to a contract or agreement or is required by statute  
27 to administer such claims and payments.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	October 1, 2021	19a-755a(a)(2)(A)
