## AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF LOW CARBON CONCRETE IN STATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Departments of
- 2 Administrative Services and Transportation to use low carbon concrete
- 3 to the extent feasible in any state construction project.

## Statement of Purpose:

To reduce emissions associated with concrete in any state construction projects in an effort to combat climate change.
