***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM TO PROVIDE  
INCENTIVES FOR TEACHERS TO LIVE IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a pilot program in
- 2 school districts with the highest populations of low-income students
- 3 and students of color to provide incentives for teachers, including, but
- 4 not limited to, teachers of color, that work in such districts to live in
- 5 the municipalities in which such districts are located.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To establish a pilot program to provide incentives for teachers to live in certain municipalities.
