AN ACT REQUIRING THE PUBLIC UTILITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY TO ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR NATURAL BARRIER PRESERVATION AND MAINTENANCE BY ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2021) (a) For purposes of this
- 2 section, "natural barrier" means trees, shrubs, bushes or other vegetation
- 3 between the facilities of an electric distribution company, as defined in
- 4 section 16-1 of the general statutes, and any residential neighbor to such
- 5 facility.
- 6 (b) On or before January 1, 2022, the Public Utilities Regulatory
- 7 Authority shall adopt regulations, in accordance with chapter 54 of the
- 8 general statutes, requiring the preservation and maintenance of existing
- 9 natural barriers by each electric distribution company. The Public
- 10 Utilities Regulatory Authority may initiate a proceeding to consider the
- 11 implementation of such regulations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to adopt regulations ensuring electric distribution companies preserve and maintain existing natural barriers.
