AN ACT RAISING THE AGE FOR A JUVENILE TO BE ARRESTED FOR AN OFFENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 46b of the general statutes be amended to raise the
- 2 minimum age at which a child may be arrested to fourteen years.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide children with support rather than arrest by increasing the minimum age of a child in the juvenile justice system to fourteen years of age.
