AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR GRANTS-IN-AID TO NONPROFIT HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES PROVIDERS FOR CERTAIN CAPITAL AND INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
4 fifty million dollars, provided twenty-five million dollars of said
5 authorization shall be effective July 1, 2023, the proceeds of which shall
6 be used by the Office of Policy and Management for the purpose of
7 providing a grants-in-aid to nonprofit health and human services
8 providers for renovations of existing facilities, construction of new
9 facilities, upgrades to information technology systems, alterations and
10 improvements in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act,
11 improvements to energy systems and the purchase of vehicles.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for the nonprofit grant program to provide grants to nonprofit health and human services providers for certain capital and infrastructure projects.
