AN ACT ELIMINATING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATION IN CIVIL ACTIONS ALLEGING SEXUAL ABUSE, SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OR SEXUAL ASSAULT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 52-577d of the general statutes be amended to remove
- 2 the time limitation on bringing a civil action for personal injury caused
- 3 by sexual abuse, sexual exploitation or sexual assault.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the statute of limitation on bringing a civil action for personal injury caused by sexual abuse, sexual exploitation or sexual assault.
