AN ACT REQUIRING THE REPORTING OF AN OVERDOSE OF AN OPIOID DRUG TO THE PATIENT'S PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 19a-127q of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 hospitals and emergency medical services personnel that treat a
- 3 patient for an overdose of an opioid drug to report such overdose to
- 4 the patient's primary care physician.

Statement of Purpose:

To require reporting of an opioid overdose to a patient's primary care physician.
