AN ACT EXPANDING THE GOOD SAMARITAN LAW TO PROTECT INDIVIDUALS WHO KEEP A SUPPLY OF OPIOID ANTAGONISTS ON THEIR PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 52-557b of the general statutes be amended to expand
- 2 the good samaritan law to property owners and administrators who
- 3 maintain a supply of an opioid antagonist on the property.

To expand the good samaritan law to property owners and administrators who keep opioid antagonists on their property.
