AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRACKING BY POLICE OF CERTAIN PERSONS CONVICTED OF CRIMES OF ABUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require certain persons
- 2 convicted of domestic violence crimes or other significant abuse to wear
- 3 a tracking device that would keep police advised of the offender's
- 4 location.

Statement of Purpose:

To enable police to track certain persons convicted of domestic violence crimes or other significant abuse.
