AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE PREVALENCE OF THE HEPATITIS C VIRUS IN CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS AND FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective October 1, 2019*) The Department of Correction, in
- 2 collaboration with the Department of Public Health, the Insurance
- 3 Department and the Comptroller, shall study the prevalence of
- 4 inmates in correctional institutions and facilities with the hepatitis C
- 5 virus. Such study shall include, but need not be limited to, the (1)
- 6 screening of inmates for the hepatitis C virus, (2) feasibility of
- 7 treatment of inmates who test positive for the virus, (3) health
- 8 outcomes of such inmates, (4) cost of and insurance coverage for such
- 9 treatment, and (5) feasibility of leveraging available federal funds to
- 10 cover the cost of such treatment. Not later than January 1, 2020, the
- 11 Commissioner of Correction shall report, in accordance with the
- 12 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, regarding the
- 13 findings of such study.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
