AN ACT CONCERNING ILLEGAL PARKING IN A SPACE RESERVED FOR PERSONS WHO ARE BLIND OR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (l) of section 14-253a of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to increase the fine for parking illegally in a space reserved
- 3 for persons who are blind or persons with disabilities to two hundred
- 4 fifty dollars for a first-time violation and five hundred dollars for a
- 5 subsequent violation and to provide that blocking the cross hatch lines
- 6 of such a space shall be subject to a fine.

Statement of Purpose:

To strengthen parking laws for persons who are blind or persons with disabilities by increasing the fine for a violation.
