AN ACT CONCERNING COMPLETION RATES AT PRIVATE OCCUPATIONAL SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Office of Higher Education shall
- 2 conduct a study relating to the completion rates of enrolled students at
- 3 private occupational schools in the state. Not later than January 1, 2022,
- 4 the office shall submit a report, in accordance with the provisions of
- 5 section 11-4a of the general statutes, of the results of such study to the
- 6 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 7 matters relating to higher education.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following		
sections:
