***AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY CONCERNING INNOVATION AND
ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN THE STATE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Economic
2 and Community Development shall conduct a study relating to
3 methods that the Department of Economic and Community
4 Development may use to encourage innovation and entrepreneurship
5 in the state. Not later than February 1, 2020, the commissioner shall
6 submit a report on the results of such study to the joint standing
7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
8 relating to commerce, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-
9 4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
