***AN ACT REQUIRING INDIVIDUALS WHO INSTALL SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS TO COMPLETE AN ELECTRICIAN APPRENTICESHIP.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1       Section 1. Section 20-340c of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2       following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2019*):

3       The Electrical Work Board shall recommend regulations consistent  
4       with the provisions of sections 20-332 and 21a-7 to establish solar  
5       electric contractor and journeyman licenses, for solar electricity work,  
6       as defined in section 20-330, which shall be adopted by the  
7       Commissioner of Consumer Protection, in accordance with the  
8       provisions of chapter 54. Such regulations shall specify that any person  
9       who installs a commercial or residential solar energy system shall be a  
10       licensed electrician or shall be registered as an electrician's apprentice  
11       prior to installing such system.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
