AN ACT REQUIRING THE PROMPT PAYMENT OF CONTRACTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 4a-60j of the general statutes be amended to (1) exempt
- 2 parties of certain commercial and state set-aside construction contracts
- 3 from statutory prompt payment provisions if they explicitly agree to
- 4 different payment terms in a written construction contract, and (2)
- 5 shorten the time periods for required payment of general contractors
- 6 and subcontractors on both public and private construction contracts
- 7 from thirty days to twenty-five days, in certain cases.

Statement of Purpose:

To shorten the time periods for required payment of general contractors and subcontractors on both public and private construction contracts.
