AN ACT REQUIRING THAT THE ADULT CHILDREN OF A PERSON WHO EXECUTES A POWER OF ATTORNEY BE PROVIDED WITH A COPY OF THE DOCUMENT UPON EXECUTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 15c of the general statutes be amended to require that a
- 2 person who prepares a power of attorney on behalf of another person
- 3 shall make a good faith effort to ensure that the adult children of the
- 4 person executing the power of attorney shall be provided with a copy
- 5 of the power of attorney upon its execution.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote transparency in the handling of legal affairs through the use of a power of attorney.
