AN ACT CONCERNING A PASSIVE MEDICAID REDETERMINATION PROCESS FOR CERTAIN AGED, BLIND OR DISABLED RECIPIENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2023) As used in this section,
- 2 "passive Medicaid redetermination" means a process by which a
- 3 Medicaid enrollee is determined to maintain eligibility for Medicaid
- 4 based on available asset and income data without having to reapply for
- 5 eligibility or take other action in accordance with federal law. The
- 6 Commissioner of Social Services shall use a passive Medicaid
- 7 redetermination process for aged, blind or disabled persons enrolled in
- 8 HUSKY C, as defined in section 17b-290 of the general statutes, (1) who
- 9 are receiving long-term care services, and (2) whose financial
- 10 circumstances are stable, provided the Department of Social Services
- 11 has access to sufficient information in order to redetermine their
- 12 eligibility in accordance with federal law.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:

Section 1	July 1, 2023	New section
