AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PROXY ADDRESS PILOT PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUALS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS OR HOUSING INSECURITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2023*) (a) As used in this section:
- 2 (1) "Proxy address" means any mailing address provided for the use
- 3 of any individual experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity;
- 4 (2) "Individual experiencing homelessness" means any person who
- 5 does not have permanent shelter or sufficient income or resources to
- 6 secure such shelter; and
- 7 (3) "Housing insecurity" means the lack of a stable or adequate living
- 8 situation due to unsafe or overcrowded conditions or an imminent risk
- 9 of eviction or other loss of permanent housing.
- 10 (b) The Commissioner of Housing shall establish a pilot program to
- 11 provide individuals experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity
- 12 with proxy addresses. The pilot program shall be designed to serve not

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more than one thousand qualifying individuals and provide proxy addresses for such individuals for not less than one year. The commissioner may establish eligibility criteria as necessary to ensure the effective operation of the pilot program.

- (c) The Commissioner of Housing shall establish procedures for the administration of the pilot program, including, but not limited to, the issuance, use and maintenance of proxy addresses. Such procedures shall not be deemed a regulation for purposes of chapter 54 of the general statutes. The commissioner may contract with a third-party vendor to provide proxy address services and may utilize any existing programs offered by the United States Postal Service.
- (d) Proxy addresses provided under the pilot program shall (1) be confidential and not be a public record for purposes of the Freedom of Information Act, as defined in section 1-200 of the general statutes, (2) not be subject to disclosure under the provisions of section 1-210 of the general statutes, and (3) not be disclosed except as necessary for the administration of the pilot program or as required by law or pursuant to a court order. The commissioner shall take reasonable steps to protect the privacy and security of proxy addresses and the holders of such addresses.
 - (e) Any proxy address provided under the pilot program shall not be used for the purpose of establishing status as an elector of any municipality of the state.
 - (f) The commissioner shall submit a report, in accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to housing not later than October 1, 2024. Such report shall include an analysis of the number of individuals served by the pilot program, the impact of the pilot program on individuals experiencing homelessness and housing insecurity, and any recommendations for the continuation or expansion of the pilot program. The pilot program shall terminate on July 1, 2025.

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- 45 Sec. 2. (Effective July 1, 2023) The sum of two hundred fifty thousand
- 46 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Housing from the General
- 47 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, for the proxy address pilot
- 48 program established pursuant to section 1 of this act.

Statement of Purpose:

To (1) require the Commissioner of Housing to establish a pilot program to provide proxy addresses for individuals experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity, and (2) appropriate funds for such pilot program.
