AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH EDUCATION IN SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to expand the health
- 2 curriculum for public schools by requiring that at least twenty class
- 3 periods be offered in grades six, eight, ten and twelve, and requiring
- 4 that the health curriculum be evaluated and modified to add
- 5 instruction relating to the dangers of vaping, the basic terminology of
- 6 health insurance and the impact of social behaviors on mental health.
