## AN ACT CONCERNING FISCALLY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require that, for
- 2 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, and each fiscal year thereafter, any
- 3 local or regional board of education with an average daily
- 4 membership, as defined in section 10-261 of the general statutes, equal
- 5 to or less than fifteen thousand pupils shall become an independent
- 6 special purpose government with the authority to fix and collect taxes
- 7 and to issue debt for the provision of educational services.

## Statement of Purpose:

To increase school district transparency and accountability by making school districts fiscally independent entities.
