AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS BY THE LEGISLATIVE OFFICE OF FISCAL ANALYSIS TO CERTAIN EDUCATION DATA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2023*) (a) (1) The Commissioner of
2 Education shall biennially submit to the legislative Office of Fiscal
3 Analysis a report on data relating to students collected in the state-wide
4 public school information system, pursuant to section 10-10a of the
5 general statutes. Such data shall include the following information for
6 each student: (A) Grade; (B) resident municipality; (C) reporting district;
7 (D) each facility attended; (E) whether the student receives a free or
8 reduced-price lunch; (F) whether the student is an English language
9 learner; (G) any special program status code; and (H) whether the
10 student is enrolled at no expense to the resident municipality.

11 (2) Such report shall not include any personally identifiable
12 information of students, such as names or the unique student identifier
13 assigned to each student.

14 (b) The report on data relating to students shall be submitted (1) after
15 February second, but not later than February fifteenth, and such

16 submission shall include student data for the current school year, and
17 (2) not later than August thirtieth, and include student data for the prior
18 school year.

19 (c) The report on data relating to students shall be submitted to the
20 legislative Office of Fiscal Analysis on compatible magnetic media, as
21 determined by the office in consultation with the commissioner.

22 (d) Any information included in the report on data relating to
23 students may only be used by employees of the legislative Office of
24 Fiscal Analysis for the purpose of research and reporting in the course
25 of their duties for the General Assembly. No such employee may
26 disclose or otherwise make known any such information that would
27 allow or lead to the identification of any student.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
