Substitute Bill No. 6899



AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESS BY THE LEGISLATIVE OFFICE OF FISCAL ANALYSIS TO CERTAIN EDUCATION DATA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2023*) (a) (1) The Commissioner of
2 Education shall biennially submit to the legislative Office of Fiscal
3 Analysis a report on data relating to students collected in the state-
4 wide public school information system, pursuant to section 10-10a of
5 the general statutes. Such data shall include the following information
6 for each student: (A) Grade; (B) resident municipality; (C) reporting
7 district; (D) each facility attended; (E) whether the student receives a
8 free or reduced-price lunch; (F) whether the student is an English
9 language learner; (G) any special program status code; and (H)
10 whether the student is enrolled at no expense to the resident
11 municipality.

12 (2) Such report shall not include any personally identifiable
13 information of students, such as names or the unique student identifier
14 assigned to each student.

15 (b) The report on data relating to students shall be submitted (1)
16 after February second, but not later than February fifteenth, and such
17 submission shall include student data for the current school year, and
18 (2) not later than August thirtieth, and such submission shall include
19 student data for the prior school year.

20 (c) The report on data relating to students shall be submitted to the
21 legislative Office of Fiscal Analysis on compatible magnetic media, as
22 determined by the office in consultation with the commissioner.

23 (d) Any information included in the report on data relating to
24 students may only be used by employees of the legislative Office of
25 Fiscal Analysis for the purpose of research and reporting in the course
26 of their duties for the General Assembly. No such employee may
27 disclose or otherwise make known any such information that would
28 allow or lead to the identification of any student.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
