AN ACT CLARIFYING THE AUTHORIZATION PROCESS FOR EMPLOYEE PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require public employers to
- 2 honor the terms of each employee's payroll deduction authorization,
- 3 subject to the following conditions: (1) The employee may only revoke
- 4 the authorization pursuant to the terms of the authorization he or she
- 5 signed, (2) deductions shall start the pay period after the employer
- 6 receives notification of the authorization, (3) requests to authorize dues
- 7 or other deductions shall be directed to the union rather than the
- 8 employer, (4) requests to revoke or change the authorization shall be
- 9 directed to the union rather than the employer, (5) a union need not
- 10 provide an employer a copy of the employee's authorization unless a
- dispute arises about the existence or terms of the authorization, and (6)
- 12 a union shall indemnify the employer for any claims made regarding
- 13 such deduction.

Statement of Purpose:

To change and clarify the authorization process for employee payroll deductions.
