AN ACT CONCERNING REGIONAL EXERCISES ON EMERGENCY RESPONSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) At least once every two
2 years, the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, in
3 conjunction with the Connecticut Police Chiefs Association, shall
4 organize and conduct a regional training exercise, involving state,
5 regional and local agencies, on responding to a major emergency.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To require regional exercises on responding to major emergencies at least once every two years.
