AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONVEYANCE OF UNUSED PARCELS OF STATE LAND TO TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the state convey any parcel of state land that is more than fifty
- 2 acres and less than sixty acres and that has been unused by the state
- for at least five years, to the town where such parcel is located, for fair
- 4 market value.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit towns to purchase and use state properties of a certain size that have been unused for many years.
