AN ACT EXPANDING THE KATIE BECKETT WAIVER PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective July 1, 2019) The sum of ____ dollars is
- 2 appropriated to the Department of Social Services, from the General
- Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, to increase capacity for
- 4 and reduce the waiting list of the Medicaid waiver program
- 5 established pursuant to section 17b-283 of the general statutes that
- 6 provides home and community-based services to persons who (1) are
- 7 institutionalized or at risk of institutionalization; (2) are twenty-one
- 8 years of age or younger; (3) have a physical disability and may also
- 9 have a co-occurring developmental disability; and (4) meet the
- 10 financial eligibility criteria established for the waiver program.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
