AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXECUTION OF LAND CONVEYANCE DOCUMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 47-5 of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective
- 3 October 1, 2019):
- 4 (a) All conveyances of land shall be: (1) In writing; (2) if the grantor
- 5 is (A) a natural person, subscribed, with or without a seal, by the
- 6 grantor with his own hand or with his mark with his name annexed to
- 7 it or by his agent authorized for that purpose by a power (i) executed,
- 8 acknowledged and witnessed in the manner provided for
- 9 conveyances, or [, if the grantor is] (ii) executed, acknowledged and
- 10 witnessed in the same manner provided for in section 1-350d, as
- amended by this act, and subsection (a) of section 1-350r, or (B) a
- 12 corporation, limited liability company or partnership, subscribed by a
- duly authorized person; (3) acknowledged by the grantor, his agent or
- such duly authorized person (A) to be his free act and deed, or (B) in
- any manner permitted under chapter 6 or chapter 8; and (4) attested to
- 16 by two witnesses with their own hands.
- 17 Sec. 2. Section 1-350d of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 18 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2019*):

A power of attorney must be dated and signed by the principal or in the principal's conscious <u>physical</u> presence by another individual directed by the principal to sign the principal's name on the power of attorney and witnessed by two witnesses. A signature on a power of attorney is presumed to be genuine if the principal acknowledges the signature before a notary public, a commissioner of the Superior Court or other individual authorized by law to take acknowledgments.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
