AN ACT CONCERNING STUDENT TRUSTEES AND THE ELECTION OF ALUMNI TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 10a-103 of the general statutes is repealed and the
 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2019*):

(a) There shall continue to be a Board of Trustees for The University
of Connecticut to consist of [twenty-one] <u>twenty-three</u> persons,
[twelve] <u>thirteen</u> to be appointed by the Governor, who shall reflect the
state's geographic, racial and ethnic diversity; two to be elected by the
university alumni; [two] <u>three</u> to be elected by the students enrolled at
the institutions under the jurisdiction of said board; and five members
ex officio.

(b) On or before July 1, 1983, the Governor shall appoint [members]
 trustees to the board as follows: Four [members] trustees for a term of
 two years from said date; four [members] trustees for a term of four
 years from said date; and four [members] trustees for a term of six

14 years from said date. Thereafter, the Governor shall appoint trustees of 15 said university to succeed those appointees whose terms expire, and 16 each trustee so appointed shall hold office for a period of six years 17 from the first day of July in the year of his or her appointment, 18 provided two of the trustees appointed for terms commencing July 1, 19 1995, and their successors shall be alumni of the university, one of the 20 trustees appointed for a term commencing July 1, 1997, and his or her successors shall be such alumni and one of the members appointed for 21 22 a term commencing July 1, 1999, and his or her successors shall be such 23 alumni. On or before July 1, 2020, the Governor shall appoint one 24 additional trustee to serve a term of one year commencing on July 1, 25 2020, provided such trustee shall be enrolled as a full-time student in 26 the School of Law, the School of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the 27 School of Social Work or as a graduate student of a school or college of 28 the university at the time of his or her appointment and for the 29 duration of his or her term. Thereafter, the Governor shall appoint a 30 trustee to succeed a student appointee whose term expires and each 31 trustee so appointed shall serve for a term of two years commencing 32 on July first of the year of his or her appointment, provided such 33 trustee shall be enrolled as a full-time student in the School of Law, the 34 School of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the School of Social Work 35 or as a graduate student of a school or college of the university at the 36 time of his or her appointment and for the duration of his or her term.

37 <u>(c)</u> The Commissioner of Agriculture, the Commissioner of 38 Education, the Commissioner of Economic and Community 39 Development and the chairperson of The University of Connecticut 40 Health Center Board of Directors shall be, ex officio, members of the 41 board of trustees. The Governor shall be, ex officio, president of said 42 board.

(d) The graduates of all of the schools and colleges of said university
shall, prior to September first in the odd-numbered years, elect one
trustee, who shall be a graduate of the institution and who shall hold
office for four years from the first day of September succeeding his or
her election. Not less than two or more than four nominations for each

48 such election shall be made by the alumni association of said 49 university, provided no person who has served as an alumni trustee 50 for the two full consecutive terms immediately prior to the term for 51 which such election is to be held shall be nominated for any such 52 election. Such election shall be conducted [by mail] prior to September 53 first under the supervision of a canvassing board consisting of three 54 members, one appointed by the board of trustees, one by the board of 55 directors of the alumni association of the university and one by the 56 president of the university. No ballot in such election, whether in paper or electronic form, shall be opened until the date by which 57 58 ballots must be returned to the canvassing board. In such election, all 59 graduates shall be entitled to vote by signed paper or electronic ballots. [which have been circulated to them by mail and which shall be 60 returned by mail.] Vacancies occurring by death or resignation of 61 62 either of such alumni trustees shall be filled for the unexpired portion 63 of the term by special election, if such unexpired term is for more than 64 eighteen months. When the unexpired term is eighteen months or less, 65 such vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the board of directors 66 of said alumni association.

67 (e) On or before November 1, 1975, the students of The University of 68 Connecticut shall, in such manner as the board of trustees of said 69 university shall determine, elect two trustees, each of whom shall be 70 enrolled as a full-time student of said university at the time of his or 71 her election. One such [member] trustee shall be elected for a term of 72 one year from November 1, 1975, and one for a term of two years from 73 said date. Prior to July first, annually until June 30, 2021, such students 74 shall, in accordance with this section and in such manner as the board 75 shall determine, elect one [member] trustee of said board, who shall be 76 so enrolled at said university at the time of his or her election and who 77 shall serve for a term of two years from July first in the year of his or her election. On or before July 1, 2020, such students shall, in 78 79 accordance with this subsection and in such manner as the board shall determine, elect one additional trustee who shall be enrolled as a full-80 time student at said university at the time of his or her election and 81

82 who shall serve a term of one year commencing July 1, 2020. 83 Thereafter, in accordance with this subsection and in such manner as 84 the board shall determine, on or before July first such students shall elect two trustees of said board in odd-numbered years and one trustee 85 86 in even-numbered years who shall be enrolled as full-time students at 87 said university at the time of their election and who shall serve for a 88 term of two years from July first in the year of their election. The student [member] trustee elected to fill the term [expiring] 89 90 commencing on [June 30, 2003] July 1, 2001 and July 1, 2020, and such 91 elected [member's] trustees' successors, shall be enrolled as a full-time 92 undergraduate student at a school or college of the university and shall 93 be elected by the undergraduate students of the schools and colleges of 94 the university. The student [member] trustee elected to fill the term 95 [expiring] commencing on [June 30, 2004] July 1, 2002, and such elected 96 [member's] <u>trustee's</u> successors, shall be enrolled as a full-time student 97 in the School of Law, the School of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, 98 the School of Social Work, or as a graduate student of a school or 99 college of the university, and shall be elected by the students of the 100 School of Law, the School of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the 101 School of Social Work and the graduate students of the schools and 102 colleges of the university. Any student [member] trustee elected after 103 July 1, 2013, shall be enrolled as a full-time student at the time of his or 104 her election and for the duration of his or her term of service. Any 105 vacancies in the elected membership of said board shall, except as 106 otherwise provided in subsection (d) of this section, be filled by special 107 election for the balance of the unexpired term. Any increase to the 108 student membership on said board of trustees shall not impact the 109 membership of students on any other boards related to or established 110 by said university.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
