## Substitute Bill No. 7185



## AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF ETHICS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) The Office of State Ethics shall

2 conduct a study of the current laws contained in the State Codes of

Ethics for public officials and for lobbyists to determine whether any

4 amendments are necessary to increase government oversight of such

officials and lobbyists. Not later than February 1, 2026, the executive

6 director of the Office of State Ethics shall submit a report, in accordance

7 with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint

8 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of

9 matters relating to government oversight. Such report shall include any

10 findings of such study and recommendations for necessary legislation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
