***AN ACT PERMITTING THE ISSUANCE OF NUMBER PLATES WITH EIGHT CHARACTERS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (s) of section 14-49 of the general statutes is  
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
3 *October 1, 2019*):

4 (s) A fee of sixty-nine dollars shall be charged in addition to the  
5 regular fee prescribed for the registration of a motor vehicle, including  
6 but not limited to any passenger motor vehicle or motorcycle, in  
7 accordance with this section for a number plate or plates for such  
8 vehicle bearing any combination of no more than eight letters or  
9 numbers requested by the registrant and which may be issued in the  
10 discretion of the commissioner, except in any case in which the  
11 number plates bear the official call letters of an amateur radio station.  
12 [On and after July 1, 2011, the fee shall be sixty-nine dollars.]

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
