AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF MUNICIPAL GAIN TO SUPPORT REGIONALIZATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 16-233 of the general statutes is repealed and the
following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2019*):

3 Each town, city, borough, fire district or the Department of Transportation shall have the right to occupy and use for any purpose, 4 5 including, but not limited to, efforts to consolidate administrative and 6 business office functions and information technology associated with 7 such functions with other towns, cities, boroughs or fire districts and 8 other entities, without payment therefor, one gain upon each public 9 utility pole or in each underground communications duct system 10 installed by a public service company within the limits of any such 11 town, city, borough or district. The location or relocation of any such 12 gain shall be prescribed by the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority. 13 Any such gain shall be reserved for use by the town, city, borough, fire 14 district or the Department of Transportation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	October 1, 2019	16-233

Statement of Purpose:

To specify that a municipality may use the gain on each public utility pole reserved for such municipality for the purpose of consolidating back-office functions with other municipalities and other entities.
