RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION REQUIRING A TWO-THIRDS VOTE TO ENACT NEW UNFUNDED MUNICIPAL MANDATES.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That article third of the Constitution of the state be amended to
- 2 require the approval by a vote of at least two-thirds of the members of
- 3 each house of the General Assembly to enact any new state mandate for
- 4 which no state reimbursement is provided to local governments for
- 5 costs resulting from such new mandate.

Statement of Purpose:

To propose a constitutional amendment to require a two-thirds vote to enact unfunded municipal mandates.
