RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT CONCERNING TERMS OF OFFICE FOR LEGISLATORS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the state Constitution be amended to (1) increase from two years
- 2 to four years the term of office for members of the General Assembly,
- and (2) provide for staggering of such four-year terms so that only half
- 4 of such members are up for election every two years.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase legislative terms from two years to four years and provide for staggering of such terms.
