RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT CONCERNING TERM LIMITS FOR CERTAIN LEGISLATORS.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That section 10 of article third of the Constitution of the state be
- 2 amended to provide that no senator or representative shall serve more
- 3 than five terms in such office, unless such senator or representative is
- 4 elected to a leadership position in the General Assembly.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish term limits for certain legislators.
