RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO PERMIT NO-EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the Constitution of the state be amended to allow any qualified
- 2 elector to cast an absentee ballot without needing to satisfy a specific
- 3 reason enumerated by law, rather than be required to appear at a
- 4 polling place on the day of an election.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the requirement that an elector satisfy a particular reason specified by law in order to cast an absentee ballot.
