Substitute House Joint Resolution No. 58

RESOLUTION PROPOSING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO ALLOW NO-EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 Section 1. That the following be proposed as an amendment to the
- 2 Constitution of the State, which, when approved and adopted in the
- 3 manner provided by the Constitution, shall, to all intents and purposes,
- 4 become a part thereof:
- 5 Section 7 of article sixth of the Constitution is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 7. The general assembly may provide by law for voting in the
- 8 choice of any officer to be elected or upon any question to be voted on
- 9 at an election by qualified voters of the state who [are unable to] will not
- appear at the polling place on the day of election. [because of absence]
- 11 from the city or town of which they are inhabitants or because of
- 12 sickness or physical disability or because the tenets of their religion
- 13 forbid secular activity.]
- 14 RESOLVED: That the foregoing proposed amendment to the
- 15 Constitution be continued to the next session of the General Assembly
- 16 elected at the general election to be held on November 8, 2022, and
- published with the laws passed at the present session, or be presented

- 18 to the electors at the general election to be held on November 8, 2022,
- 19 whichever the case may be, according to article sixth of the amendments
- 20 to the Constitution. The designation of said proposed amendment to be
- 21 used on the ballots at such election shall be "Shall the Constitution of the
- 22 State be amended to permit the General Assembly to allow each voter
- 23 to vote by absentee ballot?"
