RESOLUTION ADOPTING CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT POLICIES: THE PLAN FOR CONNECTICUT, 2018-2023.

Resolved by this Assembly:

1 WHEREAS, the Continuing Legislative Committee on State 2 Planning and Development is charged by chapter 297 of the general 3 statutes with promulgating a state plan of conservation and 4 development; and

5 WHEREAS, the Continuing Legislative Committee on State 6 Planning and Development has, since 1976, overseen the process of 7 drafting, improving, refining and revising the state plan of 8 conservation and development which has been carried out by the 9 Office of Policy and Management; and

10 WHEREAS, the Continuing Legislative Committee on State 11 Planning and Development has held meetings and hearings and has 12 incorporated the recommendations of municipalities and stakeholders 13 into the plan; and

14 WHEREAS, the plan incorporates six growth management 15 principles, namely (1) redevelop and revitalize regional centers and 16 areas with existing or currently planned physical infrastructure; (2) 17 expand housing opportunities and design choices to accommodate a 18 variety of household types and needs; (3) concentrate development 19 around transportation nodes and along major transportation corridors 20 to support the viability of transportation options; (4) conserve and 21 restore the natural environment, cultural and historical resources, and 22 traditional rural lands; (5) protect and ensure the integrity of 23 environmental assets critical to public health and safety; and (6) 24 promote integrated planning across all levels of government to address 25 issues on a state-wide, regional and local basis; and

26 WHEREAS, the Continuing Legislative Committee on State 27 Planning and Development has submitted the newly revised plan to 28 the General Assembly with its recommendation for approval of the 29 plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Conservation and
Development Policies: The Plan for Connecticut, 2018-2023, as reported
to the General Assembly by the Continuing Legislative Committee on
State Planning and Development is adopted.
