**RESOLUTION CONVENING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN SPECIAL
SESSION.**

Resolved by this Assembly:

1 That pursuant to Article III of the amendments to the state
2 constitution, and Rule 33 of the Joint Rules of this session, we the
3 members of this General Assembly judge it necessary that there be a
4 special session of the General Assembly, that said session be convened
5 not earlier than 12:01 a.m. on July 22, 2019, and that the call of the
6 session be solely for the purposes of considering and enacting bills
7 concerning workforce training needs, revision to and regulation of
8 gratuities permitted or applied as part of the minimum fair wage and
9 evidence of good faith belief that underpayment of wages for less than
10 the minimum fair wage was lawful.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the clerks of the Senate and the
12 House of Representatives deliver a copy of this resolution to the

13 Secretary of the State forthwith.
