Substitute House Joint Resolution No. 230

RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO RESCIND PREVIOUS APPLICATIONS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY CALLING FOR AN ARTICLE V CONVENTION TO PROPOSE AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES.

Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution requires the
- 2 United States Congress, upon application of two-thirds of the
- 3 legislatures of the several states, to call a convention for the purpose of
- 4 proposing amendments to the United States Constitution; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Connecticut General Assembly, pursuant to said
- 6 Article V, previously made application to the United States Congress to
- 7 call such a convention for the purpose of proposing such an amendment
- 8 or amendments concerning participation in a world federal
- 9 government, through the adoption of Senate Joint Resolution 15 of the
- 10 1949 January regular session; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Connecticut General Assembly, pursuant to said
- 12 Article V, also previously made application to the United States
- 13 Congress to call such a convention for the purpose of proposing such an
- 14 amendment or amendments concerning taxation of income of residents
- of one state by another state, through the adoption of Senate Joint
- 16 Resolution 9 of the 1958 March special session; and

- 17 WHEREAS, the Connecticut General Assembly no longer wishes the 18 United States Congress to consider said previous applications to call 19 such conventions. 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Senate Joint Resolution 21 15 of the 1949 January regular session and Senate Joint Resolution 9 of 22 the 1958 March special session are rescinded, canceled, voided, nullified 23 and superseded upon passage of this resolution; and 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the State transmit 25 copies of this resolution to the Speaker and Clerk of the United States 26 House of Representatives, to the President and Secretary of the United 27 States Senate and to each member of the Connecticut congressional 28 delegation, with the respectful request that the full and complete text of 29 this resolution be printed in the Congressional Record.
