AN ACT CONCERNING CONSUMER PROTECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require Internet service
- 2 providers operating in the state to register with the Public Utilities
- 3 Regulatory Authority and pay an annual registration fee, to require the
- 4 Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to apply net neutrality principles
- 5 to Internet service providers in Connecticut and to require a civil
- 6 penalty be imposed by the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority for
- 7 failure of an Internet service provider to comply with such principles
- 8 where each day in violation is a separate offense.

Statement of Purpose:

To require Internet service providers to register and to require the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to apply net neutrality principles to Internet service providers and enforce such principles with civil penalties.
