## AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORIZATION OF A CASINO GAMING FACILITY IN EAST WINDSOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (c) of section 12-578f of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to eliminate the requirement that the amendments to the
- 3 Mashantucket Pequot procedures, the Mashantucket Pequot
- 4 memorandum of understanding, the Mohegan compact and the
- 5 Mohegan memorandum of understanding concerning the operation of
- 6 a casino gaming facility in the state be approved by the Secretary of the
- 7 United States Department of the Interior.
