AN ACT REDUCING PRESCRIPTION DRUG PRICES UNDER THE MEDICAID PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- That chapter 319v of the general statutes be amended to authorize the Commissioner of Social Services to reduce prescription drug costs
- 2 the Commissioner of Social Services to reduce prescription drug costs
- 3 under the Medicaid program by establishing: (1) A price cap that
- 4 requires (A) additional negotiation for prescription drug rebates with
- 5 manufacturers and review by the board established pursuant to
- 6 section 17b-274d of the general statutes whenever the cap is exceeded,
- 7 and (B) further restrictions on prescription drug purchases and
- 8 transparency regarding actual prescription drug manufacturing costs
- 9 when negotiations fail, and (2) a transparent reimbursement model for
- 10 pharmaceutical benefit managers that allows the state Medicaid
- 11 program to pay the discounted cost for prescription drugs negotiated
- 12 by such managers.

Statement of Purpose:

To lower health care costs under the Medicaid program.
