AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING IN CERTAIN TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate 4 five million dollars, the proceeds of which shall be used by the 5 Department of Housing for the purpose of providing grants-in-aid to 6 the towns of Fairfield, Easton, Newton and Bethel to develop affordable 7 housing.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding for the development of deed-restricted affordable housing units in the towns of Fairfield, Easton, Newton and Bethel.
