AN ACT CONCERNING THE BURDEN OF PROOF DURING ADVERSE DETERMINATION AND UTILIZATION REVIEWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- That sections 38a-591c, 38a-591e and 38a-591g of the general statutes
- 2 be amended to require that health carriers bear the burden of proving
- 3 that certain health care services under adverse determination or
- 4 utilization review are not medically necessary.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that health carriers bear the burden of proving that certain health care services under adverse determination or utilization review are not medically necessary.
